RULES

1. In the event of two or less entries in any one In Hand class, the Lampeter Welsh Pony & Cob Association (hereafter known as the **Association**) reserve the right to cancel the class. In this instance, Exhibitors will be notified as soon after the closing date of entry as possible, and their fees returned.
2. In the event of two or less entries in any one Ridden class, the Association reserves the right to cancel or amalgamate classes. In this instance, Exhibitors will be notified as soon after the closing date of entry as possible, and their fees returned should the class be cancelled.
3. Only animals entered for the Show are allowed on the Show Field.
4. All Riders must wear a hard hat with strap meeting current EU standards PAS 015 (2001), VG1 (provided they are BSI Kitemarked).
5. No Equine under the age of 4yrs (from the 1st January in the current year) may compete in the Ridden and Harness classes.
6. All colts, 3 years old and over must be shown with a bit.
7. All entries must be registered or eligible for registration in the Welsh Stud book.
8. Ministry of Agriculture's licences of W.P.C.S. Veterinary Certificate/Licences should be available for inspection on Show Day for ALL In hand Stallions.
9. For any Class that provides an excessive number of entries forward, the judges will be under no obligation to place an undetermined number of exhibits that fall short of a required standard.
10. The Judge's decision is FINAL provided Rules have been adhered to.
11. The Organisers shall not be responsible for anything that may happen, through accident or otherwise to any exhibitor, animal or article brought to the Show Ground.
12. All Competitors must have their own Public Liability Insurance.
13. All Complaints must be made to the Secretary within ONE hour of the class in question complete with £50. The £50 will be returned should the complaint be upheld.
14. Under NO Circumstances will any unsportsmanlike conduct be permitted on the showground. Any such behaviour will result in said individual and their equines being asked to leave the showground immediately.
15. All dogs to be kept on leads at all times.
16. The Show President, Judges and any next of kin will NOT be allowed to exhibit at the Show.
17. NOVICE CLASSES – Open to competitors who have not won a 1st prize before 1st January of the current year. Anyone contravening these rules will be disqualified from competing at Lampeter Stallion Show in the future. All novice equines must be ridden in a snaffle bit.
18. All Section Champions MUST compete in the Supreme Championship or forfeit their Prize Money.
19. PRIZE MONEY – All prize money to be collected from the Treasurer.
20. By Entering, Competitors agree for their details to be displayed in the official catalogue, and to be released to appropriate third parties.
21. Please be aware that there will be an Official Photographer at the show and the Association reserve the right to use photographs taken at this show in any of their publications/Social Media.

ENTRY AT THE SHOW GATE

Exhibitors will be sent admission tickets to the show ground, TWO Tickets for first TWO Equines and ONE Ticket per TWO Equines thereafter.

PLEASE NOTE – exhibitors without tickets will be charged FULL ADMISSION. Any competitors not willing to accept this will be reported to the Secretary.
